•	WHAT IS GISA ?
	 GISA is the Galtung-Institut's Summer Academy for professional training in Advanced Conflict Transformation. GISA consists of 4 weeks of intense training designed for any and all participants seriously interested in acquiring conflict transformation skills as well as for such participants interested in upgrading their conflict resolution competencies to state of the art professional standards.

•	WHAT WILL I LEARN?
	 SOLUTION INDICATIVE CONFLICT ANALYSIS. Throughout the 4 weeks, the focus of training will be on scrutinizing conflict formations and anticipating their dynamics in order to (a) prevent their escalation from cultural violence to structural violence to direct violence and (b) solve so called intractable conflicts. Participants will learn to analyze and resolve conflict formations at all levels of social interaction, namely between (a)individuals (micro level), (b)social groups (meso level),
	(c)nations, (d)states (macro level) and (e)civilizations (mega level).
•	HOW LONG?
•	 From July 1st to July 31st 2016, GISA is offering 4 intense weeks of professional training in applied conflict resolution & conflict transformation. Week 1: July 04th to 08th: Mega conflicts & key concepts with Prof. Galtung. Week 2: July 11th to 15th: Micro & meso conflicts with Dr. Faldalen & Prof. Van der Veer. Week 3: July 18th to 22nd: Macro conflict formations with Prof. Paul Scott. Week 4: July 25th to 29th: Mediation & Reconciliation Simulations by Naakow Grant-Hayford. If 4 weeks are too long, you may consider enrolling for a specific week of interest.
